



## **DUTY OF CARE**

The Davenport Dolphins Swimming Club has a duty of care for its participants from the time the swimmers arrive for their session (not before their allocated time) until the end of their allocated session (Plus changing time). A Coach or committee member of the Club will not leave anyone under the age of 18yrs by themselves and will remain with them until collected by a responsible adult. However, you are reminded that the Club is NOT A BABY SITTING SERVICE.

**PLEASE REFER TO THE POLICY ON THE WEBSITE 'DROPPING OFF, COLLECTING CHILDREN AND KEEPING THEM SAFE'**

To enable the Club staff to provide this Duty of Care, we are asking you to provide details of the person who is collecting your child (especially if not yourself). We are aware that some swimmers have parental permission to go to and from practice sessions independently, (either by walking / biking or even by car). If this is the case, then we need to know and have your written permission. Please complete the attached form and return ASAP to your squad coach.

Please complete a separate swimmers details form for each swimmer in your family. This information will be kept by the squad coach.

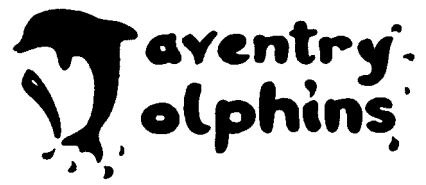
