- 6-7pm Silver Squad - Stage 9 Skill and stroke development
- 7-9pm Olympic Squad - Target age 12-19 years involved in the Club's Performance Programme

Davenport Dolphins Swimming Club is a competitive club in Northamptonshire having enjoyed unprecedented success over the past 8 years under the leadership of our Head Coach, Rob Sharp. Davenport Dolphins competes in the Arena Autumn League Division 3, Leicester Diddy Autumn and Winter Leagues as well the Northants ASA Championships, East Midland Regional Championships, Home Nations Championships, Open Water and regular Open Meets at age group and Masters levels.

Due to the Continued Professional Development of the Head Coach on Monday evenings from September 2017, a vacancy to join the coaching team has arisen. The successful applicant will lead the coaching sessions of three squads from 5pm until 9pm.

As Relief Coach, you will be required to:

- Liaise with the Head Coach regarding planning, leading and delivering progressive coaching sessions as appropriate to the level and ability of the swimmers including:
- To improve/develop the technical skills of the swimmers on all four strokes
- To improve/develop the swimmer's technique with regard to racing starts and turns (ensuring capability with regards to ASA guidelines/FINA rules)
- When applicable, to liaise with the Head Coach with regard to swimmer progressions
- Maintain the quality of club coaching by continuing to develop your own qualifications and continued personal development and to liaise with the Head Coach to identify appropriate development opportunities for training

To be a success in this role you must:

- Possess an ASA/UKCC Level 2 Coach and/or Teacher Qualification (or equivalent)
- Have a passion for the sport and a desire to help every swimmer achieve their full potential

- Be dynamic and personable with the ability to inspire and motivate young people whilst working effectively with the wider coaching team
- Have good knowledge and ideally some previous experience of competitive swimming

This is a part time role, working 4 hours per week with the possibility of additional hours for holiday /sickness cover. Additional hours for attendance at team galas may be required.

The Club does not operate on Bank holidays and has reduced sessions during the Christmas / New Year break and summer holidays
